The Gaudí Exhibition Center is a new exhibition space in the recently refurbished Barcelona Diocesan Museum close to the Cathedral, in the city centre.

The museum houses *Walking with Gaudí*, an extraordinary exhibition concerning the work and personality of Antoni Gaudí. A unique collection of the great architect's works, objects and documents. They represent almost a century of international research into Gaudí, the man, his work and his revolutionary way of working. **The Gaudí Exhibition Center** has a series of technological installations that stimulate the mind with exciting sensations. Technology supplied by the technological partner **gives visitors an innovative, virtual reality experience** using augmented reality and interactive content that add another dimension to the visit.

With just 1 hour visit, students could learn the most important aspects about the most famous and universal Catalan architect. Thinking in young people, the Gaudí Exhibition Center offers an entertaining visit, with the newest technologies which make that students have fun time at the same time that they learn. Students will receive a form with questions about the Gaudí works, to be completed during the visit.
